



MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION

between

Utah State University

Logan, Utah, USA

and

Indonesian Dean Communication Forum

Association of Faculty of Teacher Training and

Education Palembang, Sumatra, Indonesia



The Indonesian Dean Communication Forum Association includes membership of the 32 Deans of Faculty of Teacher Training and Education. The universities include Universitas Sriwijaya, Universitas Sultan Ageng Tirtayasa, Universitas Syiah Kuala, Universitas Riau, Universitas Maritim Raja Ali Haji, Universitas Jambi, Universitas Bengkulu, Universitas Lampung, Universitas Terbuka, Universitas Siliwangi, Universitas Sebelas Maret, Universitas Jember, Universitas Trunojoyo Madura, Universitas Mataram, Universitas Nusa Cendana, Universitas Tanjungpura, Universitas Mulawarman, Universitas Palangkaraya, Universitas Borneo Tarakan, Universitas Lambung Mangkurat, Universitas Tadulako, Universitas Khairun, Universitas Pattimura, Universitas Cendrawasih, Universitas Musamus, Universitas Malikussaleh, Universitas Tidar, Universitas Haluoleo, Universitas Papua, Universitas Singaperbangsa Karawang, Universitas Timor, and Universitas Sulawesi Barat.

Utah State University and the Indonesian Dean Communication Forum Association of Faculty of Teacher Training and Education, desiring to develop academic exchange and cooperation in teaching and research in the furtherance of the advancement and dissemination of learning, agree as follows:

1. Cooperation. Each university and the association agrees:
 - (a) to encourage academic staff from the participating universities to visit the other campuses for the purpose of participating in joint teaching, joint research, joint conferences, and joint cultural programs;
 - (b) to offer admission to qualified undergraduate and graduate students from the other universities;
 - (c) to encourage the exchange of academic materials, publications, and information between the universities; and
 - (d) to prepare, as necessary, working programs detailing specific forms and contents of cooperation.
2. Limitations. Each party acknowledges that all visits of staff and admissions of qualified students will be subject to compliance with (i) the entry, visa, and travel regulations of the United States of America and Indonesia and (ii) the receiving university's requirements with respect to staff appointments/visits and student admissions.
3. Financial Arrangements. Each university understands that any and all financial arrangements must be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.
4. Term and Termination. This Memorandum shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years, commencing on the last date of signature set forth below. This Memorandum may be terminated (i) at any time by mutual consent of the universities or (ii) by either university providing to the other university notice of termination, whereupon this Memorandum will terminate six (6) months after such notice. This Memorandum may be renewed or amended by the mutual and written agreement of the universities.
